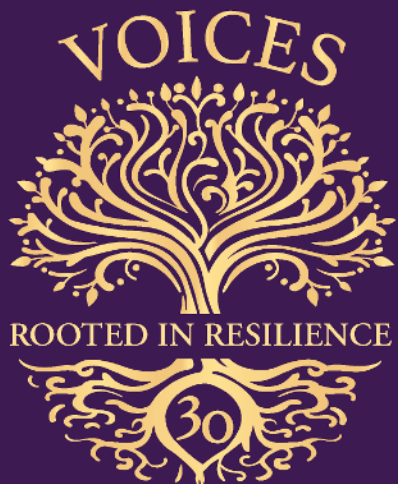




CHANA: Honoring 30 Years

From a single crisis line, one employee and a safe house, we have grown into a lifeline for thousands.
